### IV. Principal's Update - Dr. Amy Besser, Principal

- Budget top of mind had budget meeting last week. State funding for schools is lower than anticipated. Covid funds not available but we will be ok.
- Students showed growth in math and reading, diagnostics. Our teachers just ended PDSA cycle looking at student achievement.
- LA's BEST 40 students enrolled. Orientation tomorrow.
- Tutor Me starting next week
- Preparing to order new textbooks. CKLA reading program we must adopt. Will visit the teachers at Nestle to see program in action.
- Promethean boards will be on wheels and are interactive boards. Up to schools to pay
  for them. Not aware of any grants to order them. Would need 24 boards, but would not
  include UTK rooms cuz they have their own separate budget. Cost is high. E-Team may
  be able to supplement cost for them.

- Checking: \$181,000 approx
- Saving: \$201,000 approx
- Profit is \$65k on \$311k of income
- Budget is projected to go to June so will not go over it now until we really go over the budget. We have hit exactly or exceeded our events. Enrichment is the only one that has projected differently. We overprojected cuz we did not factor in permit costs.
